1. Initial

Enroute

<p>All</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - PPE - Decide roles: Attending, O₂, AED - Additional personnel required? - Siren OFF for last block! - Drop a cone at driveway
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Arrive on Scene

Attending person	O₂ person	AED person
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Call on scene - Grab jump kit 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - (Call on scene?) - Grab O₂ kit 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - (Call on scene?) - Grab AED

Approaching Patient (same room)

2. Setup

Primary Survey

Attending person	O₂ person	AED person
LOC DABC Announce decision to begin CPR Move patient to work space as required	Clear work space Assist with moving patient	Clear work space Assist with moving patient

Begin CPR

Attending person	O₂ person	AED person
2 rescue breaths with pocket mask Cut & remove clothing - scissors Become Compression person	Set up near patient's head Open O ₂ kit <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Crack valve - Obtain BVM and hose - Connect BVM to O₂ - Set regulator to 15 lpm Become Bag person	Open AED <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Turn AED on - Position AED next to Attending - Open electrode pack and connect to AED - Apply electrodes to patient Become Mask person



3. Continuing

Continuing CPR

<u>Compression person</u>	<u>Bag person</u>	<u>Mask person</u>
Start or Resume CPR - 100 bpm Count out loud	Time BVM breaths to every 10 th compression Obtain, size and insert OPA Handle radio if required until additional personnel are on scene	Hold modified jaw thrust Hold firm seal on mask

"PRESS ANALYZE" (shift change)

<u>Compression person</u>	<u>Bag person</u>	<u>Mask person</u>
Press Analyze Move to bag station Check for pulse Become Bag person	Move to mask station Become Mask person	Move to compressions station Become Compression person - or retire if new personnel taking over at Compressions

SHOCK ADVISED (charging)

<u>Compression person</u>	<u>Bag person</u>	<u>Mask person</u>
Continue CPR	Continue breathing for patient	Continue to hold mask

PRESS SHOCK

<u>Compression person</u>	<u>Bag person</u>	<u>Mask person</u>
Ensure all clear Press SHOCK Call out time of shock	Clear (Call out time of shock)	Clear (Call out time of shock)

NO SHOCK ADVISED, or after shock

- Cycle back to "Continuing CPR"



4. Additional Personnel Arrive

<u>New Person</u>	<u>Retiring Mask person</u>	<u>Other people</u>
Take over at Compressions station on next Analyze shift change	Assist with family Begin secondary (paperwork)	Provide any assistance required Prepare to take over at Compressions
